- Writing journalistic pieces with a distinct news angle that appeal to our diverse audiences and in particular attract media outlets to cover the work of Siemens Stiftung.
- Contribute to speech writing for our board members or project managers as well as to script writing for video statements, podcasts and others.
- Collaborate closely with the project leads in our working areas and the communications team of Siemens Stiftung to help translate our core narrative and communications strategy objectives in attractive content.

## What you should bring with you

- Proof of a completed scientific university degree (Master, Magister or Diploma) in a field of study relevant to the area of responsibility - preferably journalism, communication sciences, political science or a humanities or social science degree
- Passion for topics connected to social sustainability and several years of work experience as a

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- Talent and competence for writing, creativity, confidence in style and the ability to prepare complex contexts in an understandable, creative and target-group-oriented manner
- Excellent feeling for language and excellent written expression
- Professional expertise in the editorial support of social media channels

- Knowledge of common IT user programs (skills in image processing and video editing programs is an advantage)
- English and German native speaker, knowledge of Spanish is an advantage
