

Education crisis

Climate change education (CCE) & foundational learning?

Lack of funding

- Education world not familiar with climate world
- 1.5% of the climate funds are allocated to education (World Bank 2024)

Conceptual challenges

- Confusion between Climate change education (CCE) and Education for sustainable development (ESD)
- Minimal integration into school curricula
- Sometimes, low quality (no local relevance, catastrophism...)
